PROGRAMS

Advocacy: Through fact-based advocacy, awareness and education, we ensure that the voices of the homeless are heard to help increase funding and change regulations.

Technical assistance and capacity building: CHIP conducts extensive training and provides staffing support to increase the capacity of local housing and service providers and facilitate the development of new collaborations that enhance client outcomes.

Research and data analysis: On behalf of the Indianapolis Continuum of Care, CHIP administers an electronic data collection system that stores personal information about those who access homeless services. The data is used to inform community planning, improve coordination of services, support advocacy efforts, and enhance funding requests
